Ian Carruthers - chair of the International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board (IPSASB) since January 2016, having served as a member since 2010. As a member, he led the IPSASB's work on Long Term Financial Sustainability and alignment between IPSASs and Government Finance Statistics. After joining HM Treasury from PricewaterhouseCoopers in 1999, Ian played a key role in the UK Government's transition from cash to accrual budgeting and reporting, in particular leading its Whole of Government Accounts programme.

Thomas Müller-Marqués Berger - Global Head of International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSASs) for Ernst & Young GmbH, as well as Chair of the Public Sector Group of Accountancy Europe. He also serves on the European Commission (EC) and EUROSTAT European Public Sector Accounting Standards Task Forces, and is a member of the EU Advisory Group on Accounting Standards and a member of the German Public Sector Committee of the IDW.
